THOMAS EDISON

Thomas Alva Edison (1847 – 1931) was an American inventor known for the development of the incandescent lamp and the phonograph.

He was a surprising person. Born poor, he studied for only three months in a public school. When he was twelve, he started selling newspaper to help his family. But he never stopped reading and experimenting during all his life. His first patent was registered when he was 21 years old – an electrical vote recorder.

He also developed:

- automatic telegraph systems;
- the electric pen (on which modern photocopy is based);
- the carbon transmitter (on which Bell's telephone is based);
- the "Ediphone" for office dictation;
- methods for the generation and distribution of electricity;
- better dynamos;
- the electric train;
- the "kinetoscopic camera" (movie camera) and many other inventions.

Edison worked on several forms of invention for more than 50 years and registered a total of 1,033 patents.
